Refund Policy

A refund will be made ONLY if the contingent is full and there is another Scout who is (1) an acceptable replacement, (2) approved by the Jamboree Leadership and (3) who has paid up according to the Jamboree Payment Schedule.

The only exception will be (1) a death in the family (Parents or Legal Guardian, Siblings or Grandparents) or (2) A signed doctor's letter stating that the applicant IS NOT physically able to attend the 2017 National Jamboree.

2017 National Scout Jamboree

Request to Attend Form

Council Contingent—The Pee Dee Area Council currently has been allocated 1 Troop consisting of **36 youth** and **4 adult leaders** to attend the 2017 National Scout Jamboree, which will be held at Summit Bechtel Family National Scout Reserve in New River Gorge, West Virginia. Please complete the information below if you wish to be considered for this event.

To attend a Scout must meet the following qualifications:

- Scouts must be at least a First Class Scout by July 19, 2017.
- Scouts must have completed sixth grade or be at least 12 years of age by July 19, 2017 and have not reached your 18th birthday.
- Participate in pre-jamboree shakedowns—**mandatory attendance** (conducted by Pee Dee Area Council). (Dates TBA)
- Be approved by your Scoutmaster and the local Pee Dee Area Council Jamboree Committee.

Financial Details—The total cost for participants (youth and adults) will be \$1650.00. This fee includes Jamboree program, transportation, meals, lodging, special Pee Dee Area Council items (only for participants), use of patrol and troop equipment, and all-Jamboree shakedowns. Scouts must submit this form along with a \$450.00 deposit to be considered. Three additional payments of \$400.00 each will be due May 15, 2016, July 15, 2016 and November 15, 2016. Anyone making their initial Jamboree registration after May 15, 2016 will owe the cumulative amount due on the date of registration to reserve their place. The \$450.00 deposit is non-refundable. Subsequent payments are non-refundable unless the contingent is full, and fees are paid in full by the wait list youth. Please refer to the Jamboree Refund Policy stated on the flip side of this brochure.

Registration on a First Come-First Served Basis.

Registration—All youth are required to register online at www.bsajamboree.org. After you have signed up on the National System, then submit this Request to Attend form along with initial deposit to Pee Dee Area Council. This form must include the parents (or legal guardian) and Scoutmaster's approval to be considered. There will also be a mandatory parent/scout orientation meeting to be held (*Date and Location to be announced soon*).
